In his role as the Executive Director of the orchestra and chorale, he led them in a magnificent performance.

It is heartwarming to see our Council attract new members who want to advance their position in the K of C and serve our parish and community.

Many of our parishioners visited the Icon to pray to Our Blessed Mother for intercessions and blessings. Among her many titles, she will always be Mary, Queen of the Knights.

Our new Fall fundraisers, the Christmas Magnet Sale and the Thanksgiving Pie Sale, were very successful. The proceeds have enabled us to expand our Christmas support of needy families.

The men of our Council always impress me with their charity. For example, a Brother Knight from Vineland had a house fire that was a total loss. He is married with two young children. Our Council voted to donate \$100 from our charitable funds. Then, our members took out their checkbooks and made personal donations of \$400. This is the spirit upon which the Knights of Columbus was founded. Charity is the first principle of our Order.

It was a surprise to most of the **Brother Knights** that so many vendors showed up so early.


**Josie** and her team had allocated more than **50** slots outside and **20** slots inside.


