Brother Knights,

I am thrilled to report that the *Columbian Year* ending *June 30, 2012* was an incredible year for our Council. We earned **Supreme's Double Star Award** for exceeding our membership and insurance goals by over *200%*. We added 15 new members to our Council and had 8 current Knights transferred into our Council.

We also scored a trifecta in **State Council** awards. Based on our recommendations, **Monsignor Marucci** was named **Chaplain of the Year** for the State, **Frances Mann** of Saint Andrew's was named **CCD Teacher of the Year** for the State and **Rob Parry**, son of **Brother Knight Sam Parry**, received the **K of C NJ State Scholarship**.

For the first time ever, we had 5 Brothers earn the Shining Armor Award (see the details in a separate article in this newsletter).

During the year, we added a significant number of <u>new</u> activities:

- Assisted with parking and ushering at the special Christmas Eve Mass
- Bought 2 cases of winter coats for needy children
- Bought CD players for Little Angels Academy classrooms

- Partnered with Galaxy Youth Group with a sandwich project to feed the homeless
- Sponsored Monsignor Marucci's anniversary dinner
- Sponsored 3 families for the Breakfast with Santa
- Sponsored a Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest for parish children
- Awarded the first Mignogna Family Scholarship
- Mother's Day Coach Purse raffle
- Served as cooks for the Saint Andrew's Parish movie night

We are also off to a terrific start for the new Columbian Year. So far, we have 6 new members and 5 current members who are transferring to our Council. Our new members have told me that they joined our Council because they were looking for an active men's organization. I think they have found it.
