# Grand Knight Message

Brother Knights,

As we close our year and begin a new year, I would like to thank all of our members who contributed their time and effort to help in the growth of our Council. It is an honor to be a Grand Knight for a very special group of individuals.

Our 2013-2014 Columbian year included the Dedication of the Sanctuary, Tabernacle, and Chapel by Bishop Dennis Sullivan, with a followqu Jubilee Gala Dinner. Throughout the ceremony, St. Jude Council Members were visible giving support as participants, as ushers, and during our introduction of the St. Andrews Christmas Ornament. Our sales from the Christmas Ornaments and other fundraising activities enabled us to donate over \$5,000 to the St. Andrews Tabernacle Relocation Fund. In fact, we attained Star Council only five months into our Columbian Year -- a milestone that normally requires a full year to achieve. Since so many of our new members have stepped up and

led many of our activities, I am sure we will continue to have a vibrant Council, both for St. Andrews and for the needy in our community.

This Membership past spring, our new Committee designed a recruiting brochure and set up an open house for new candidates. Our membership has reached 136, and this will provide us an opportunity to increase our activities to support St. Andrews Parish and our community. Most importantly, the Membership Committee developed a mentor program to help new members feel more comfortable in their new adventure as a Brother Knight. Based on the help of the Membership Committee, we completed all the requirements to achieve Double Star Council for the third year in a row. We will again be part of the 250 of 13,000 Councils worldwide who have achieved this important honor. We may also stand alone as the only Council to achieve Double Star status 3 consecutive years.


