I am establishing a time schedule and will ask each of you volunteers to pull a 2 hour shift on whatever day & time is best for you and whether or not you want to be involved in another part of the Fest tasks like Parking, Beer Booth sales etc.? If we get enough volunteers (hopefully at least one man for 2 hours) to be in the KC Information Booth along with me, staffing should be OK. As you can see, we need 14 more shift volunteers in order to satisfy minimal coverage, so I hope some of you other Brother Knight's will sign-up and help-out.
