## Congratulations On the 40th Anniversary of Your Ordination

Robert Rizzo grew up on the West side of Chicago. He attended Our Lady of Sorrows and St. Anthony (Cicero) elementary schools, and St. Mel High School. In 1966, he entered the Niles (St. Joseph) College Seminary and earned his degree in sociology from Loyola University. He received his Masters Degree in Divinity for Ministry from St. Mary of the Lake Seminary, Mundelein, Illinois.

Father Rizzo was ordained on May 8, 1974. He served as a parish priest at St. Peter Canisius in Chicago until 1979. His journey continued on at St. Barbara in Bridgeport (1979-1980), St. Edward (1980-1987), St. Lambert (1987-1988), St. William (1988-1997), and St. Paul of the Cross (1997-2004). In 2005, Father Rizzo became pastor at St. Hubert.
