# The ''Feed My Starving Children'' event was held on September 27, 2016

Our Field Representative, Pierre Zermatten helped to organize a rather large enthusiastic group of volunteers for the Feed my Starving Children event. Eight of these volunteers were Knights from our Council 6964. As you can read below, our group packaged up 20,304 Meals in about an hour's time that night. This was good enough to feed 56 kids for a year. Everyone did a great job. In the pictures below, you will see that we all had to wear hairnets for sanitary reasons.

Founded in 1987, Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) is a Christian non-profit Organization that provides nutritionally complete meals specifically formulated for malnourished children. The process is simple. Donations given by people just like you fund the meal ingredients. Volunteers hand-pack the meals. Meals are donated to FMSC food partners around the world, where kids are fed and lives are saved! FMSC consistently receives the highest awards for accountability and transparency, with more than 90 percent of total donations dedicated directly toward feeding kids in need.




