Thank you to everyone who worked and/or donated to our ID Drive. It's all because of you!

Special thanks to my co-chairs Tom Senese and Mike Sulentic. As well, Tony Colucci who put in so many hours making our pre-sales so successful, and our Corner Captain Ron Bonieck.

My wife, Joyce, especially continues as my pillar of strength.

This was our best year. We improved in every category: Pre-Sales, Corners, Stores, & Churches.

We had 142 individual volunteers help this year - up by 19 from last year.

There were 92 Knights, 63 Family, Friends and Charity Workers, 25 Elite Stars, 6 TKEN, 5 St. Hubert Gift Program, and a representative from the Special Camps Program.

We all worked 610 hours - Up 50 hours over last year

We filled 266 Positions. - Up 27 positions from last year

To put our collections in perspective: - We took in 35% from corners, 19% from stores, 14% from Churches, 28% from Pre-sales and 3% Post-Sales.

Thank you all for making this our best drive ever. Please do let me know how we can improve.


