Chaplain's Corner



Brother Knights,

I want to share a reflection of the "Lord's Prayer" for your Lenten journey. Just like the disciples of Jesus, we know what we need to pray, but do we understand what we pray? This is the perfect time to break down the prayer that Jesus gave us, and to work on understanding his words. It isn't just the words He uses that are important, but the attitude of mind and heart that should accompany them.

Our Father - tells us what our relationship is, to whom we pray.

Who art in heaven - identifies where our Father resides.

Hallowed be Thy Name - praises God for Who He is.

Thy Kingdom come - expresses our longing for Him.

Thy will be done - asserts our solidarity with the desires of His heart.

On earth as it is in heaven - recognizes the scope of His sovereignty.

Give us this day - admits our immediate dependence on Him.

Our daily bread - acknowledges that every element of our existence is a gift from Him.

And forgive us our trespasses - confesses the reality of our shortcomings.

As we forgive those - reminds us that He expects us to forgive others.

Who trespass against us - exhorts us to include even those who have hurt us the most.

And deliver us from evil - gives us consolation by giving us what we often need the most.

The Lord's Prayer has been called the perfect prayer because it contains those words and attitudes that are necessary, not just in approaching God with reverence and awe, but with honesty and humility in acknowledgment of our own human condition and needs.
