

throughout the United States and Canada. Shipping charges are added to each order, but the Supreme Council works with our supplier to ship via the most economical means possible, and the Supreme Council picks up half of the shipping costs on every order placed by a Knights of Columbus council. Each case of high-quality coats will contain either boys or girls coats, both of which come in a variety of sizes, styles and colors. Our order will be for coats appropriate for our winter temperatures. Our intentions are to work with our local St. Vincent de Paul Society for distribution.



The Silver Rose Program



Beginning in April 2015, six Silver Roses began their journey across North America, from Canada to the United States to Mexico. The 2015 Silver Rose Program will conclude on December 12, 2015 on the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas, at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico.

2015 marks the 55th year of the program which began in 1960 as a project of the Columbian Squires of North America to honor the Blessed Virgin under her title as Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. The program has continued since then as a project of Columbian Squires circle, councils and Fourth Degree

assemblies.

Today six Silver Roses travel through North America exemplifying Knights of Columbus devotion to our lady and commitment to the culture of life.

One Rose begins in British Columbia and heads south along the Pacific coast before turning east on a winding path through the southwest and mountain states before reaching Texas. A second Rose starts in Alberta and heads east to Saskatchewan before entering the United States in North Dakota and travelling

through the northern US Rockies and the Great Plains on its way toward Texas. A third Rose starts its run in Manitoba, moving south through the central United States and along the Mississippi before turning to Texas. A fourth Rose begins its journey in Ontario moving through the mid-west and some of the Mid-Atlantic States before ending in Washington, D.C. A fifth Rose begins in Virginia and journeys throughout the south on its way to Texas. A sixth Rose starts in New Brunswick and travels throughout the northeast, completing its journey in Connecticut.

The four Roses in Texas are united at the International Bridge in Laredo, passed on to the Knights of Mexico for the final leg of their journey to Monterrey for the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12.

Pope Francis received one of the Silver Roses on December 12, 2014 following the celebration mass for Our Ladu.

The State Per Capita charges to the councils for each member has remained the same for over 25 years. The Budget passed at the 2015 State Convention did not change this for the coming Fraternal Year so the Texas State Council is counting on this program to fill the gap in the operational funds needed.

How it works. For only \$10, the purchaser, who must be at least 18 years of age, receives a Discount Coupon along with a FREE Pro Football Game Card. This coupon gives the buyer access to a website that will have numerous discounts good towards online and in store purchases. These offers include food, sporting goods, clothes, etc. Restaurant.com is also a featured vendor. With these services, the buyer can easily recoup the cost of the Coupon and much more!

Each Football Game Card has 4 different pro football teams preselected each week, for 10 weeks of games starting Nov. 1, 2015 and ending Jan. 3, 2016. You do not have the same 4 teams for the whole series. Each game card has 10 chances to win every week, giving you 100 chances overall to score some cash! To determine winners, the scores for the teams listed on your card for that particular week are totaled and compared to the scores of the other tickets sold. The card with the highest total points wins \$400. The top 8 cards win with second through eighth place receiving lesser amounts. If the teams on your card didn't do well at all, perhaps forgetting to come out of the locker room, the lowest scoring card receives \$60 with the second lowest card

You can follow the results each week online by going to the TKOFC.ORG website and clicking on the Football Frenzy Icon on the right side of the page. Players receive their winnings automatically from the State Office. Checks will normally be in the mail by the end of each week. If you should happen to lose your game card, no problem, the check will still be in the mail!

Unified Sports is a program that combines athletes with and without disabilities to form sports teams for training and competition.

Unified Sports dramatically increases inclusion of people with intellectual disabilities into the community by breaking down barriers that have historically kept people apart.

Partnership Profile with Special Olympics

The Knights of Columbus Partnership Profile with Special Olympics (Form 4584 due January 31) details the council's involvement recording events attended, dollars contributed, (2.5% of your councils contribution to Texas State Charities should be indicated on item iv of the form), man hours devoted to various Special Olympics competitions and events. Supreme Council awards a maximum of \$9,000 annually to each qualifying State Council. All councils are requested to file Form 4584, Partnership Profile Report with Special Olympics. This report is to be filed whether council members were involved in Special Olympics or not.

All Councils that have contributed to State Charities can take the amount contributed and multiply by 2.5%. Place that amount on the form, item IV. Total Funds Contributed to Special Olympics, Number 1. State Games/Events. Also, put the amount in the Total Contributions.

To enhance participation from councils, an Awards Program has been initiated for Diocesan and District Deputies to encourage the submission of Form 4584. To qualify for the Award the District Deputy Must have 100% of assigned Councils submit the form 4584, with all indicating activity by the January 31 due date.

Charles 'Chic' O'Connor Memorial Award

This award recognizes a Brother Knight for his exemplary contributions supporting Special Olympics in Texas. The criteria includes: Leadership, Volunteering, Fund-raising, and Community involvement.

Our recipients have been Brother Knights Bill Merrill and Henry Gonzales, both from San Antonio, Lou Struble from Austin, and Jack Harvey from Rockwall.
