Fourth Degree Assembly 1892 Leaders Meeting September 7, 2017

Opening & Prayer:

Meeting was opened by Faithful Navigator, Jerry Hawley at 5:30 P.M.. Prayer was said lead by Jerry Hawley.

New Business:

Discussions were held about the upcoming September 11 "First Responders

Appreciation" celebrations sponsored by The Knights of Columbus Fourth Degree Assemblies & area 3rd Degree Councils along with Hot Springs and Hot Springs Village Catholic Parish's.

A breakfast will be served to First Responders starting at 6:00 A.M. at the St. Mary's Of The Waters Parish Hall. Directly following the breakfast, a "Service" will be held in the Parish Church. Those Fourth Degree Sir Knights, who has "Full Regalia", should be at the St. Mary's Church Entrance to greet the First Responders as they enter for the service.

A parade will be held, starting at 6:30 P.M. From St. Mary's Church, whereas Sir Knights, in full Regalia, will march approx. one mile plus. All Third Degree Knights welcome to march in the parade wearing their Knights Shirts. Those unable to march, may ride in transportation yet to be determind (IE: Bus, Flat Bed Trailer or other means) the length of the parade. It was indicated that the Knights of Columbus would get a great deal of press by participating in this city wide celebration and parade.

Campaign For Clothing For Prisoners...Requested By Father Phillip Reaves Arkadelphia: Discussions were held on the "Guldlines" for donations of clothing for prisoners being released who has need for proper clothing.

A separate "Flyer" was given out...listing all the guildlines pertaining to the type and conditon of the clothing being donated.

"The Plan" is to locate a suitable container in the back of each participating parish. Parishioners then can place their clothing donations in. All clothing should be bagged with sizes clearly marked on the bag.

Father Phillip Reaves plans to make two deliveries each year...first collections to be a date in October, 2017, to be announced.

The Correctional Facility, that all donated clothing will be taken, will be the Ouachita River Facility. The donated clothing will be delivered by Father Reaves in person.

It was further suggested, if all area councils (Hot Springs, Hot Springs Village, Arkadelphia) could donate \$300 each, many items could be purchased to place on the K of C Table in the Silent Auction. This is a fund raiser for the St. John's Elem. School, Hot Springs, Arkansas.
