Issues with Growing Older



A cardinal and top aide to Pope Francis in charge of charity to the poor climbed down a manhole to restore power to an occupied building that hadn't had electricity for a week.

Cardinal Konrad Krajewski told local media he personally turned meters back on over the weekend at the building in Rome, which has been illegally occupied by homeless people, including families with children,

since 2013.

"I did it for the children," Krajewski told Italian newspaper Corriere della Sera, according to the country's news agency, ANSA .

Power and hot water had been out since May 6 because of unpaid bills totaling €300,000, but more than 400 people, including about 100 children were living in the space, ANSA reported.

The news agency says that the building has also become a cultural hub, with shops and other communal spaces for its occupants and activists.

Krajewski said he'd assume responsibility for the action.


"It was a desperate gesture," he told media outlets, according to Vatican News. "The absurd thing is that we are in the heart of Rome. Nearly five hundred people left to themselves. They are families who have no place to go, people who struggle to survive."




KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS ORGANIZATIONAL CHART


