- GK opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m. with a prayer
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd degree exemplification will be June 14 Sunday in the lower cafeteria 1st starts 11:00, 2nd starts 1:00 3rd starts after the 2nd
- Matt Lacaille spoke about the scholarship program. We voted to give \$3,000 to one family and \$1,250 to a second family.
 - there was discussion about youth activities and the awards to be given out
 - Matt will chair the youth activities next year
- GK noted that we planned to give \$17,500 to Special Olympics over the next 5 years (Gold Level) and we decided to make that donation in annual payments on each July 1st. We also discussed putting out a donation jar for Special Olympics at the bingos.
 - This Sunday May 31 is the 5th Sunday. K of C to meet for 8:30 a.m. Mass with breakfast after that at the VFW hall. The remembrance for this Mass is for Ben Holthaus and our veterans.
- Jim Rolwes spoke about Corpus Christi. Due to June 6th being Ballwin Days, no police are available to guard our procession. So we must process on property only, not the street.
 - Practice will be June 1st.
 - The company that produced the Omaha, Nebraska video on Corpus Christi asks for donations. We voted to give them \$100.

 - The purchase of Mass Education book was to be about \$400, but is going to be about \$650. We agreed to cover the extra cost.
