Its baseball season again as the Knights invite you to register for our Spring and Summer game, "Play Baseball with the Knights".

It couldn't be simpler to play. Here's how it works. Each registered participant will receive a randomly drawn "Play Baseball with the Knights" certificate for the 2015 baseball season. Each certificate will have the names of three National League Baseball Teams. These three teams are your teams for the entire 26week baseball season and will determine whether or not you are a winner in our game.

THERE WILL BE A WINNER EVERY WEEK!

Each week of the season our "Play Baseball" committee will total the number of runs each National League team scores during games played that week (for the purpose of this game, a week is defined as beginning on Monday and ending the following Sunday). The holder of the certificate with the three teams that scored the highest combined total number of runs that week will be awarded an amount based on the number of tickets sold (\$A).

If no one has purchased the winning ticket, the holder of the ticket that has the 3 teams with the highest points will be awarded (\$B) 60% of the award for that week. The 40% will be added to the following week's awards (A + 40%).

The holder of the certificate with the three teams that scored the fewest combined total number of runs that week will be determined by participation (C). Multiple winners divided the award.

For example, if 300 tickets were sold, A = \$105, B = \$63, C = \$35.

The weekly award amounts (A, B, C) will be posted at http://www.holyinfant-kofc.org/. You register once and you're eligible all 26 weeks. It's that easy!

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE ENTIRE SEASON COSTS ONLY \$25 (THAT'S LESS THAN \$1 PER WEEK TO PLAY!). To register for the 2015 season, complete the registration form below, and return by March 20th with \$25. We'll mail your certificate(s) to you in time for Opening Day of the 2015 baseball season.
