# GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

Dear Brother Knights,

First I want to congratulate our newest Sir Knights—Tom Broniecki, Daniel Davison, Nathan Davison, and Robert Kaiser—who made their Fourth Degree, the Patriotic Degree, at the Exemplification on February 17. Also, congratulations to our Knight of the Month for January—Frank Picha, our Family of the Month for January—Bill and Mike Fumagalli, and our newest Honorary Life Member—Jerome "Jerry" Kolpa.

In March, we will celebrate St. Patrick's Day, Palm Sunday, and Holy Week. Patrick is the patron Saint of Ireland. He was born in what is today England, Scotland or Wales. At age 16 he was enslaved by Irish raiders, transported to Ireland and held captive there for six years. Patrick later fled to England, received religious training there and later returned to Ireland as a missionary. Legend has it that Patrick stood on an Irish hillside and delivered a sermon there that drove the serpents into the sea. Ireland, however, has never had snakes. Scholars believe that snake story is an allegory for St. Patrick's eradication of pagan ideology. Until the 1700's, St. Patrick's Day was a Roman Catholic feast only celebrated in Ireland.

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday where we celebrate or Lord's triumphant entrance into Jerusalem. He spent time with Gentiles in the Temple and on Wednesday left for the Mount of Olives. He returned to Jerusalem on Thursday to share the Last Supper with His apostles. He was crucified at Calvary on Friday, outside the gates of Jerusalem, buried the same day, and arose three days later on Easter Sunday.

Our Lenten Fish Frys are in full swing. I strongly encourage you to support the fish frys and volunteer to help out at the frys, our poker events and our weekly bingo. Finally, I want to wish all of our members and their families a very prayerful Holy Week and a very Happy Easter.
