CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

One of the biggest issues that has tragically divided Christianity is the debate of faith and grace versus works. In its simplest form, going back to the rupture of the Reformation, some Christians following Martin Luther, believe that we are saved ONLY by faith and grace. This often translates into some looking at Catholics with our emphasis on Sacraments, sacrifice, doing good, works of mercy, etc. as replacing the free gift of salvation with works. In other words, some believe that Catholics are seeking to earn their salvation.

That observation is incorrect. I have always felt that this theological debate is based on misconceptions and oversimplification. I believe the whole argument can be dismissed with a simple question: Are you a better Christian today than yesterday? The answer should be, "Yes." One is never "done" with their faith. Beginning with our Baptism, we are never done. Even if one says they are "born again" or "saved," they are not done. We still have "work" to do. We should seek to grow in our relationship with the Lord and our desire to serve Him. If not, what's the point? At every Easter we renew our Baptismal Promises. Besides serving as a renewal and recommitment, it should remind us that we must be living our Faith every day and becoming better Catholics. The issue is not what I did yesterday, but what I'm doing today. There are too many Catholics who believe their salvation is in the past. They speak in terms like, "I was Baptized; I made my First Communion; I was Confirmed." That's nice. That's important. What are they doing today in their Faith?

Becoming a Knight is one way of living out our Catholic Faith. Your involvement in the Order and its good works is an example of a Catholic growing in their faith. This Easter as you renew your Baptismal Vows, renew your commitment to the Knights, and to living your Catholic Faith each and every day. We are never done! It begins new each and every day.

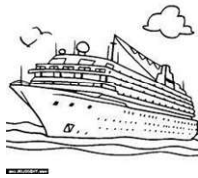

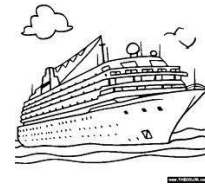

This year, just like the previous years, the Chapter will be staying in Wildwood at the Reges Hotel, located along the Atlantic Ocean on Atlantic Avenue. The dates for the 2017 State Convention are May 19 and 20th. Hopefully, we will return to the terrific weather we experienced in the past. Reservations will be processed on a **FIRST COME, FIRST CHOICE of room basis. Act now and mail the enclosed reservation form and a check for the full amount payable to “Ocean County Chapter” to the reservation chairman listed below. All reservations are due by April 17, 2017. The Chapter must make final payment for all rooms one month prior to the convention weekend.**

Room prices range from \$106 to \$134 per night based on double occupancy; there was no increase in rates from last year. Children 15 & under stay free, each additional person will be \$20 per night. 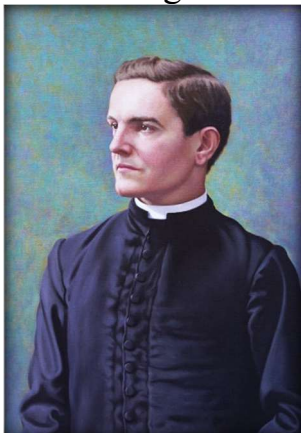

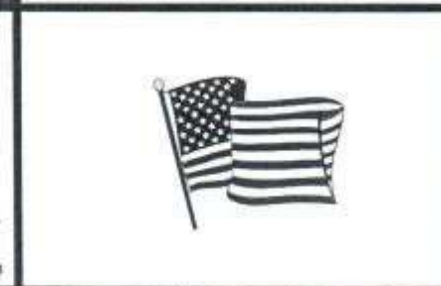
