GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

August should be known by the Knights of Columbus as the month of our founder, Father Michael J. McGivney. His life and vision is what our order is based upon, Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism.

Michael J. McGivney was born to Irish immigrants in Waterbury, Connecticut, on August 12, 1852. The eldest of 13 children (only seven of whom survived to adulthood), he studied for the priesthood and was ordained on December 22, 1877, and was assigned to St. Mary's Church in New Haven. By his holy life, exemplary virtue, piety and priestly character, he was recognized by many as "a saint in the making." Father McGivney dedicated his life to the spiritual and physical welfare of others, creating the Knights of Columbus in 1882 to provide insurance for the protection of widows and orphans, and the spiritual benefit of its members and families. The founding of the Knights of Columbus was a means rather than an end; a means to strengthen husbands and fathers so that they could, in turn, strengthen their families in the faith and secure their material well-being. Father McGivney was an idealist. He was a man whose youthful vision and creativity expanded and matured

even as his physical well-being diminished. Father McGivney died on August 14, 1890, two days past his 38th birthday.

In March of 2008, Pope Benedict XVI bestowed the title "Venerable" on Father McGivney. Please remember him in your prayers. Below is the Prayer for the Canonization of Father Michael J. McGivney.

God, our Father, protector of the poor and defender of the widow and orphan, you called your priest, Father Michael J. McGivney, to be an apostle of Christian family life and to lead the young to the generous service of their neighbor. Through the example of his life and virtue may we follow your Son, Jesus Christ, more closely, fulfilling his commandment of charity and building up his Body which is the Church. Let the inspiration of your servant prompt us to greater confidence in your love so that we may continue his work of caring for the needy and the outcast. We humbly ask that you glorify your venerable servant Father Michael J. McGivney on earth according to the design of your holy will. Through his intercession, grant the favor I now present (here make your request). Through Christ our Lord. Amen. (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory be.)




