CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

"Powder" is the name of a science fiction fantasy movie released in 1995. The main character was born prematurely to a mother that was struck by lightning. She died shortly after giving birth to her son who had great intellectual ability and paranormal powers. Abandoned by his father, he was raised by grandparents until he ended up as a "ward of the state." Despite his intelligence, he was an outcast. During a hunting trip, one of his classmates threatens him with a gun, but a shot heard in the distance catches everyone's attention. Rushing in the direction of the sound, they discover a local sheriff's deputy who has killed a deer. Distraught at the death of the animal, Powder places one hand on the dear and the other on the hunter, who appears to have a seizure. In fact, Powder, through his paranormal abilities, had allowed the hunter to feel the anguish and fear of the deer he had killed. Moved by the experience, the deputy gets rid of all his guns, unable to kill again. The experience of knowing what the dying deer felt changed the heart of the hunter.

That is the challenge of the Church, and the Knights, as we observe another anniversary of the tragedy of Roe v. Wade. We must help people feel the anguish of the unborn child. We seek to assist them to "feel" the life that is in the womb, so that like the hunter, they are no longer able to consent to its killing. That conversion would override any policy or decision. The person themselves would have an internal law that would not permit them to accept abortion. As the pro-life movement marches again in Washington, let us pray that the Knights can be like the Powder of the movie and help more and more know the reality of life in the womb—and to respect and protect it.


