Each year in the middle of Lent the Church honors St. Joseph on March 19. While little is known about this great saint, he has much to offer us as Knights of Columbus and as men of faith. In Matthew 1:19 we read that Joseph was “a righteous man.” This short description means that he was a man who kept the laws and traditions of his faith. Because of that, until God revealed other plans to him in a dream, Joseph considered divorcing Mary quietly when she was found with child.
