CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

May is a very special month. During it we honor the Blessed Mother. We honor all mothers, both living and deceased. Many young people will either graduate or complete another year of college. It is also the time of the year when children receive their First Holy Communion.

Holy Communion is, of course, one of the seven Sacraments and one of three Sacraments of Initiation, along with Baptism and Confirmation. There is a part of the Church's Sacramental theology that many Catholics do not know, but I think you will find instructive. It was defined at the Council of Trent and in Latin is stated, "*ex opera operato*" (literally: "by the very fact of the action's being performed"). What this means in plain English is that as long as we have the right stuff, the right person, and the right words, we have a Sacrament. The value of this teaching is that it removes any doubt about the effectiveness of a Sacrament, in other words that the presence and power of Christ is guaranteed. It also means that the reality of the Sacrament does not depend on the disposition or faith of either the minister or the participant. This was important in the early Church, when there were questions about the validity of a Baptism performed by a priest who had abandoned the Faith. We can see the same situation in Holy Communion. Even if a priest does not believe in the Eucharist, if he is a validly ordained priest and says the proper words over bread, there is Holy Communion.

The point of all this theology, while important, has had some negative consequences. It has led some Catholics to have an almost automatic and even mindless understanding of the Sacraments. It has allowed some Catholics to forget the other part of the equation. While a Sacrament is guaranteed, its effectiveness depends on the disposition of the participants. That is the part that Catholics forget. It is important and beautiful for a child to receive First Holy Communion, but for it to truly bear fruit in their lives they must learn to be open to the Real Presence and continue to receive. The same is true for adults. While they do indeed receive the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord, how effective it is depends on their disposition. If a Catholic receives Communion with little devotion, or prayerfulness, or love, the Sacrament will have little effect in their lives.

During this month of First Holy Communions, let us pray for all children and families to have a genuine love of the Eucharist. They us also look into our own hearts, examining our disposition as we receive Holy Communion.

"May the Heart of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament, be praised and adored, at every moment, in all the Tabernacles of the world, even to the end of time."

INSURANCE MATTERS

Only Having Insurance "Through Work" Doesn't Work


