CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

October 4, 2016 is Respect Life Sunday with the theme this year: "Every Life is Worth Living." As Knights of Columbus we can truly say that every month is Respect Life Month and we continually try to promote the dignity and value of all human life.

Life begets life and promoting life creates life. Death begets death and promoting death creates more death. We are about so much more than opposing threats to life. We are also about celebrating the wonder and beauty of life.

In the debate over life and death issues I have begun recently to adopt a new strategy. This involves a simple question to be posed to those who oppose Church teaching, in particular those who claim to be pro-choice. The simple question is this: When did your heart become hardened? I am sure that the first response would be one of confusion and resistance. The challenge is to invite the person to examine their own heart. Someone who favors abortion is stating that they have absolutely no feeling for an unborn child. The sight or thought of an aborted child does nothing to them. They are numb. That is a hardened heart. Similarly, anyone who supports euthanasia is stating that they have no stomach for the suffering of an elderly or infirm person. The only thing they can think of is to get rid of it, and not love the person.

A perfect example is the recent undercover videos that reveal the trafficking in the body parts of aborted children by Planned Parenthood. If the absolute lack of feeling displayed by them, and those who defended it, is not a hardened heart, I don't know what is.

Without realizing it, those who disagree with Church teaching are proclaiming themselves to be unfeeling or hard hearted. They believe themselves to be otherwise, but it is difficult to claim so when one at the same time states they have no feeling or emotional reaction to the taking of innocent life.
