Dear Brother Knights,

In March, the Lenten Season begins with Ash Wednesday. It is a season of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday, through which we attain redemption. It's the forty days before Easter. In the early days, people used Lent as a time of fasting and repentance. Ash Wednesday usually begins with Mass and the placing of ashes on our foreheads where we should recognize our mortality, repent of our sins, and return to our loving God. We should use the Lenten Season as a time to recognize life as a precious gift from God, and turn our lives towards God.
