GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE


Dear Brother Knights,

May is a busy month with many celebrations. Mother's Day is observed on May 14, a celebration honoring the mother of the family, as well as motherhood, maternal bonds, and the influence of mothers in society. An image or likeness of the Blessed Virgin Mary is ceremonially crowned on that day to signify her as Queen of Heaven and the Mother of the Church.

May 25 (or Sunday, May 28) we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. It is the 40th day of Easter and commemorates the ascension of Jesus into heaven. It is celebrated primarily by Roman Catholics and Anglicans and is one of the Holy Days where attendance at Mass is mandatory. The Easter (Pascal) candle is extinguished on this day.

May 29 is Memorial Day, a federal holiday in the United States for remembering the people who died while serving in the country's armed forces. It originated as Decoration Day after the Civil War when the Grand Army of the Republic, an organization of Union veterans founded in Decatur, Illinois, established it as a time for the nation to decorate the graves of the Union war dead with flowers. On Memorial Day, the flag is raised to the top of the staff and then solemnly lower to half-staff where it remains until noon when it is then raised to full staff for the remainder of the day. Tradition has it that the half staff position remembers the men and women who gave their lives in service to their country. At noon, their memory is raised by the living, who resolve never to let their sacrifice be in vain, but to rise up in their stead and continue the fight for liberty and justice for all.

I want to take this opportunity to wish the wives of all of our members a very Happy Mother's Day and to personally thank those members who were veterans and served in our armed forces. I also want to congratulate the newest members of our Council who made their Admissions (1st) Degree in April: Andrew Jones and Carlton (CJ) Jones III, plus our Knight of the Month for March: Frank Rossi, and our Family of the Month for March, the Rob Kaiser family.
