Bill Lucas and Charlie Williams spoke about the new Spirit of St. Louis West Assembly. A reason for starting a new assembly is that the existing St. Louis Assembly 565 meets far away from West County, is very large with 1200 members,

yet has about 40 members at a meeting. The new assembly would draw from 9 parishes with about 400 4th Degree Knights. 205 have submitted transfers to the new assembly. New assembly will be family oriented, has Bishop Herman as chaplain. It will have a chalice/memorial fund.

Peter Nicaster represented St. Louis Assembly 565. He urged people to stay due to the traditions in place, strength of leadership, financial strength. They are able to provide funds for various charities. They meet in a new location at 7 Holy Founders.

The new west county assembly will be the third split from the St. Louis Assembly. The others are in north county and south county.
