insured under an individual Knights of Columbus certficate.

- **B.** Death Benefits
 - 1. A \$1,500 death benefit to the family when a child dies less than 61 days after birth.
 - 2. A \$750 death benefit to the family when a child is stillborn at least 20 weeks after conception. (The Order affirms that life begins at consception. In this instance, the benefit requires a certified death certificate for the stillborn child, hence the 20week rule.
