

Happy New Year! Welcome to 2019. I wish each and every one of you a Happy, Healthy, and Prosperous New Year.

9 Days for Life - Monday, January 14th - Tuesday, January 22, 2019

Please join and prepare for these national and local Marches for Life through a novena for life. Councils can pray whatever novena they would like. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' 9 Days for Life is a great digital pilgrimage. Councils not able to participate in a march for life, please consider joining through a novena, which is a required program for the Columbian Award.

The Free Throw contest entries are due to Supreme by January 31, 2019. Please consider running a contest within your parish. This is probably the easiest contest to run that is sponsored by the KnightS Of Columbus. First, find a place to conduct a free throw contest. It can be a gym or an outside basketball court. Advertise in the Sunday parish bulletin about the dates and time the free throw contest will be conducted. Ask for participants to bring along a basketball if you do not have access to a basketball (you will be surprised how many boys and girls will bring a basketball). Both boys and girls are eligible to participate from ages 9 – 14. Winners from each gender and age group will participate in the regional contests held in the 2nd weekend of February, with the State finals held right here in San Antonio sometime in March.

The Annual Fraternal Survey is due January 31, 2019. All members should put together the amount of hours dedicated to the Knights of Columbus. Ushers, Euchristic Ministers, Lecturer, Deacons, and Priest should have their hours documented towards the Survey. For example, if you have a priest on your roster, that easily counts as 2,000 hours, and Deacons easily log 1,000 hours towards the survey. Help out the Grand Knights, and Financial

Secretaries by documenting your hours and turn them in. This is one of your responsibilities as a Knight of Columbus.

Special Olympics Partnership Profle (Form 4584)

Reminder that the Special Olympics Partnership Profile (#4584) is due by January 31, 2019.. This form outlines the amount of giving councils do for Special Olympics games locally, on a state level, regionally, and nationally. Even if you do not have any activity, the council should submit the form. Supreme allocates funds to each state for their programs based on the form entries.
