Program Categories:

Faith: Grow in faith and build a strong parish and Church. Aid priests and religious in formation, honor our Mary, mother of God, and engage in serious spiritual reflections and religious education activities.

Family: Strengthen families through faith and service. Socialize and pray with other faith-filled Catholic families through special events, religious services and volunteer opportunities.

Community: Make a powerful difference in your community. Help those less fortunate with basic human needs of clothing, shelter, mobility and compassion.

Life: Create a culture of life. Assist pregnant women in need, care for the elderly, aid the handicapped and empower those with special needs to realize their full potential.

Star Council Award

The goal of every Council is a commitment to obtain the Star Council Award. Councils that conduct well rounded Faith In Action programs will find that their activities are attractive to men of the parish. Recruitment and retention are far easier when programs invite men and their families to live their faith in service to one another, their parish and the communities in which they live and work.

The Star Council award recognizes the efforts that Councils put forth in continuing Venerable Michael McGivney's mission. In order for your Council to earn the Star Council Award, it must:

- Earn the Columbian Award for well-rounded Council programs.
- Submit the Service Program Personnel Report (#365) due by Aug. 1.
- Submit the Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity (#1728) due by Jan. 31.
- Be complaint with training and background checks.
- Remain current with assessments from the Supreme Council headquarters.

Columbian Award

Earn the Columbian Award for well-rounded Council programs. There is no reason why every Council in the Knights of Columbus should not earn the Columbian Award. It recognizes your Council's quality faith-filled family programs in each of the four Faith In Action program categories. In order for you Council to earn the Columbian Award, it must:

- Conduct at least four major programs in each of the Faith In Action categories of Faith, Family, Community and Life.
- Complete the Columbian Award Application (#SP-7) due by June 30.
- Submit the Service Program Personnel Report (#365) due by Aug. 1.

New Faith In Action Fraternal Programs Report Form (#10784)

Following the launch of the Faith In Action program model, a new form has been created that will allow reporting for most of the Supreme-recommended programs. This new form will replace 24 individual report forms, streamlining the number of forms Council officer are expected to use.

Recommended Best Practices:

- Submit one report form per program.
- This new form is an optional addition for any reporting on Featured Programs, Free Throw Championship, Soccer Challenge, Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest, or Keep Christ in Christmas Poster Contest, which each have their own report forms that are required to be submitted.
- Save copies of all report forms to assist with the completion of the Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity (#1728) and the Columbian Award Application (#SP-7)
- Use your <u>Fraternal Leader Success Planner (</u>#5033) to help document the number of programs, events charitable hours, and distributions throughout the year.
- When calculating service hours, remember that family members and volunteers assisting the Knights can be counted towards your totals.

• Reporting should be done in whole numbers only,

do not report fraction of hours or spare change.
