





These certificates are customizable within the Supplies Online application, so that you can order certificates as a high resolution download, so that you can print the certificates yourself. Certificate 11091 is used when there is no honoree, 11092 can have an honoree added, and 11093 is in honor of the beatification of Fr. McGivney.
