let us remember to help those in need. Help our neighbors, parishioner, and brother Knights.

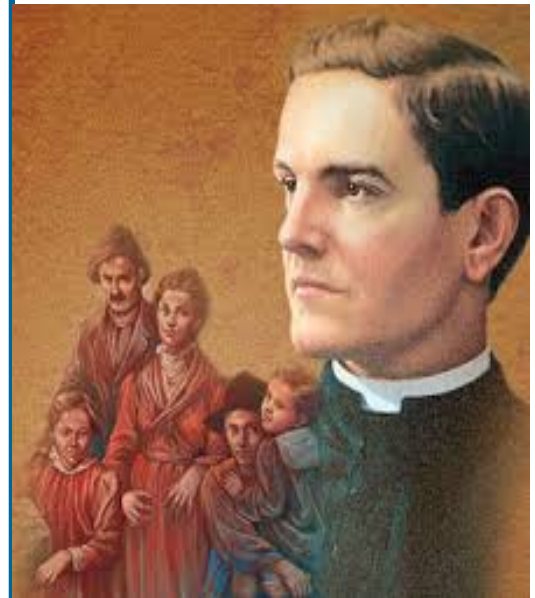

**Updated New Member Ceremonial Certificate Released:** The Supreme Council has released a new series of ceremonial certificates, featuring an image of Fr. Michael J. McGivney. The certificates are numbered 11091, 11092, and 11093, and are now available to be ordered in 'Supplies Online'. These certificates are customizable within the Supplies Online application, so that you can order certificates as a high resolution download, so that you can print the certificates yourself. Certificate 11091 is used when there is no honoree, 11092 can have an honoree added, and 11093 is in honor of the beatification of Fr. McGivney.
