



District Deputy Corner

Greetings To All My Brothers

We are off on another fraternal year, and the activities are starting to ramp up. So, what are the Councils doing to gain the confidence and support of the congregation, the Church, and the community?

Clearly the people have to know who we are, and what we do in the Knights of Columbus. We can tell them we are about charity, unity, fraternity, and patriotism all day long. But we have to put meaning behind these words if we are to gain confidence, respect, and support.



I have been encouraging lately about a simple act that each and every Brother can do for the Knights of Columbus, and for their Councils. I encourage everyone to wear their shirts to Mass or wear a symbol showing that you belong to the Knights of Columbus. It's a tool to be used for saying who we are. This way, people can then grasp some of the meaning when we speak on behalf of the Knights of Columbus.

Advertise your activities in the weekly bulletin at Church. If you are holding a fundraiser, advertise in the bulletin four weeks ahead of time. Let people know that the Knights of Columbus are active in the community, and please state how the proceeds will be used. If funds go for a special project for the priest, say so. If it goes to support another ministry within the Church, say so. It will go a long ways to gain that confidence and support within the community. And please say thank you to the community after the event whether in person, from the pulpit, or in the bulletin.

I know each Council likes to keep money on hand in the treasury. Think about establishing a minimum balance the Council will not go below. And please refer to those monies as "emergency funds". And use them wisely, in case of emergency, as the intended purpose.

Thank you for what you do and for belonging to our honorable organization. I believe we are all here for the same purpose - To Serve. Thank you for your service, your hard work, your dedication, and your loyalty. Perhaps from a retention standpoint, if active members are wearing their shirts, maybe might entice some inactive members to be moved to get back involved with the Council.
