There was a lot of interest and a promise by each of the 130 prayer book recipients to pitch the idea to their council at a business meeting. We will know if this is successfully by how many councils request the PDF and Publisher files for the prayer book in English and Spanish. Thanks go to St Rita's for donating the 65 prayer books and printing the 300 brochures. This saved \$40 and a lot of time printing these up at a commercial print shop. To date 10,000 to 12,000 prayer books have been made and distributed.
