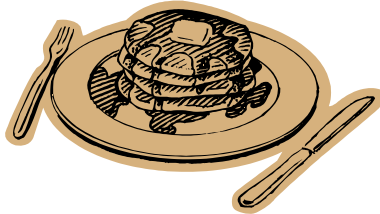

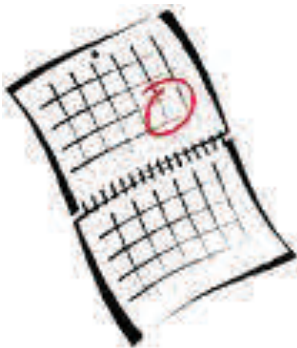


Calling all Runners
