We will have at least three teams, possibly four. Currently, the Team Leaders are our WGK Gary Wisniewski, Recorder Craig Rice and our Youth Director John 'Chili' McNicholas.
- 3. Kids 16 and over can work, but no one under 21 can sell beer. Family members are more than welcome to participate. We will only need a few teens for each team they can rotate, etc.as needed too.

We also look forward to working the Country Music Festival next Summer which is a major fundraising opportunity and also very enjoyable.
