January 22nd - Family event- Social Hall- 6:45 - 8:15; A priest and a participating family willing to share the importance of the example of the Holy Family and effects on their family.

January 27th Consecration Day; posters in Narthex; lawn signs "Consecration our Family to the Holy Family TODAY" Priests to lead the families at each mass in the Consecration Prayer w/ a special blessing.


