We lost ½ of the **Fish Frys** we would normally do and the ones we did have did less than we expected; we had to cancel the last two **Boy Scout Merit Badge** classes; we also postponed the **Golf Tournament of Hope**, which also was going to bring in a lot of needed funds!

As part of a Fraternal organization, we need to volunteer more to raise the funds we need to operate moving forward. Just look to what we have donated till March for Waypoint for the passion play & American Heritage Girls for Space Camp, which wouldn't be possible without your passionate dedication bringing in the funds.

Worthy Deputy Grand Knight **Chris Bell** challenges us to do what we can and what is necessary to make up "lost ground" to meet our commitments. He is requesting that we - all of us - think "outside of the box" on ways we can increase funds for the charities that we support.

Chris requested all our ideas on how we can offset these losses and raise much more money and suggested:

- ◆ Plan for a Strong Fall BSA Merit badge class, more volunteers are needed. Offer online classes, thoughts to implement this initiative?
