



From the Financial Secretary

2014 dues are \$41.65. During the first week of December, the Financial Secretary will mail out billing notices for 2014 annual membership dues. Please return your payment by the due date of December 15, 2013. In addition to dues of \$36.00 (\$8.50 for Honorary Members), the bill includes a Culture of Life Assessment of \$2.00 and a discretionary assessment of \$3.65 for support of religious vocations. Your timely response to this bill will save the Council the postage expense of having to mail you a second notice.

If your bill is for more than \$41.65, it is because you are in arrears on payments due last year or longer. If you no longer intend to pay dues and remain a member of the Knights in good standing, please have the courtesy of informing the Financial Secretary of this.
