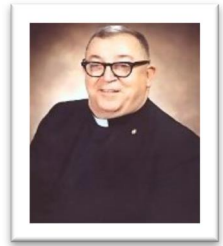

The "Pilgrim Virgin"

The "Pilgrim Virgin" practice originated in Fatima on the 30th Anniversary (May 13, 1947) of Our Lady's first apparition there. On that date, the Bishop of Leira blessed two statues of Our Lady of Fatima and sent them out on distant pilgrimages – one to the Far East, the other to the West. The statues are exact replicas of the official one, which was made according to the instructions of Lucy, and which is venerated in the Chapel of the apparitions at Cova da Iria. There is reason to believe that Our Blessed Mother herself inspired this beneficial practice of "The Pilgrim Virgin".

The basic idea of the "Pilgrim Virgin" is that most people are unable to make a pilgrimage to Fatima. Therefore, Our Lady, with characteristic humility and love, overcomes this difficulty by reversing the process. She becomes the Pilgrim. Instead of your making a pilgrimage to her home at Fatima, she makes a pilgrimage to ours. Through her "Pilgrim Statues", she is hurrying around the world collecting prayers and sacrifices in reparation for the sins committed against her Divine Son.

In August 1974, a request was forwarded to the Most Reverend Thomas Welsh, Bishop of Arlington, Virginia, seeking permission to initiate the apostolate of the Ambassadors of Mary within the Arlington Diocese. The Bishop's response was very enthusiastic. Consequently, with the Bishop's permission granted, the "Pilgrim Virgin" began her travels to the numerous homes in the Arlington Diocese.

The Father Kelly Council (5750) of the Knights of Columbus has served as the custodian for the Woodbridge-Dumfries "Pilgrim Virgin" since it was established in 1984.

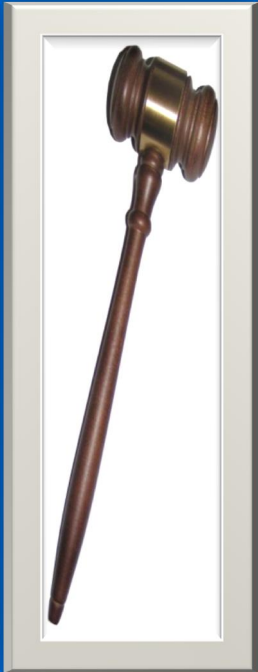
There are three ways in which you can participate in the graces which Our Lady most certainly grants to the "Pilgrim Virgin" ministry:

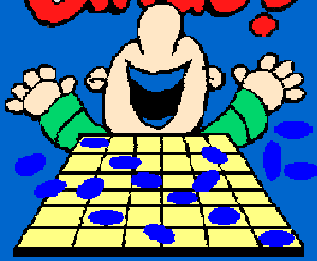

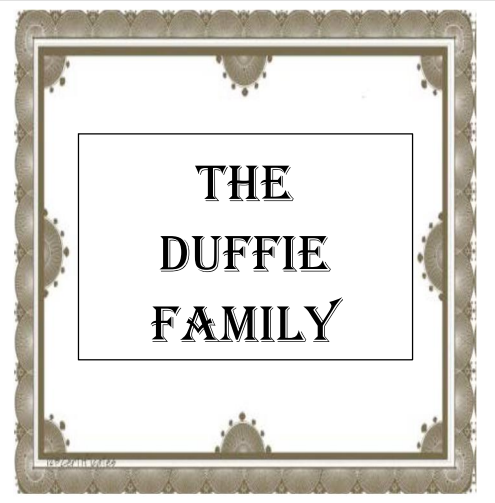
