

Third Annual Bike Ride in Philadelphia

What a fantastic day we had on our tour of the Philadelphia River Wards. Nine riders total toured churches in Fishtown, Kensington, Port Richmond, and Bridesburg. We started with a stop at St. Anne's Church in Kensington, whose wonderful priest, Fr. Brady gave us a private tour of the church, known for its traditionally Irish roots. We then rode to Port Richmond, home to five churches, each for a different ethnicity. The group visited Nativity BVM (also historically Irish), Our Lady Help of Christians (the German parish), Mother of Divine Grace (the Italian parish), and St. Adalbert's (Port Richmond's Polish parish and crown jewel), where we attended a mass in the Polish language. After mass, we stopped by Marian's Bakery, a Polish bakery, and enjoyed a box of chruściki in Campbell Square Park. We then rode to Bridesburg, and visited All Saint's Parish (historically Italian), and St. John Cantius (the neighborhood's Polish parish). We enjoyed lunch at Renzis Pizza before stopping at the Kensington's own Visitation BVM Parish. On the ride back we stopped at Little Baby's Ice Cream Parlor for a wonderful treat.
