"Prepare the Way"

Lent is the Christian season of preparation before Easter. Ash Wednesday March 5th marks the first day, or the start of the season of Lent, which begins 40 days prior to Easter

Lent is a time when many Christians prepare for Easter by observing a period of fasting, repentance, moderation and spiritual discipline. The purpose is to set aside time for reflection on Jesus Christ - his suffering and his sacrifice, his life, death, burial and resurrection.

Repentance means a sincere turning away, in both the mind and heart, from self to God. In a biblical context, repentance is recognizing that our sin is offensive to God. Repentance can be shallow, such as the remorse we feel because of fear of punishment (like Cain) or it can be deep, such as realizing how much our sins cost Jesus Christ and how his saving grace washes us clean (like the conversion of Paul).

You will find less social gatherings during the season of Lent, but not less gatherings of God's Holy People. You are encouraged to attend parish Lenten services and Soup Suppers on Friday evenings. During the Lent you may attend

Adoration of the Lord. Brother Knights keep an all night vigil beginning on the First Friday of the month until dawn. This Lent we will gather on March 7/8 and April 4/5 at the Blessed Sacrament Chapel at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel for our monthly devotion. Please consider joining us.

Please mark you calendar to celebrate in solidarity and unity the 2nd degree Exemplification on Tuesday, March 25th. This is an opportunity to invite Brothers to a moving ceremonial of Catholic Christian unity.

Recall the "3 R's" – RECRUIT –RETAIN – REMEMBER. The 2nd degree is an opportunity to REMEMBER a fellow Knight of the first order on their journey to full Knighthood. Saturday, April 12 is the next 3rd degree Exemplification.

March for Saint Joseph



The month of March is dedicated to **Saint Joseph**. He is a figure in the Gospel, the husband of Mary, the mother of Jesus and step father of Jesus. We know he was a carpenter, a working man. He wasn't rich for when he took Jesus to the Temple to be circumcised and Mary to be purified he offered the sacrifice of two turtledoves or a pair of pigeons,

allowed only for those who could not afford a lamb. We know Joseph was a compassionate, caring man. When he discovered Mary was pregnant after they had been betrothed, he knew the child was not his but was as yet unaware that she was carrying the Son of God.

We know Joseph was man of faith, obedient to whatever God asked of him without knowing the outcome. When the angel came to Joseph in a dream and told him the truth about the child Mary was carrying, Joseph immediately and without question or concern for gossip, took Mary as his wife. When the angel came again to tell him that his family was in danger, he immediately left everything he owned, all his family and friends, and fled to a strange country with his young wife and the baby. He waited in Egypt without question until the angel told him it was safe to go back.

We know Joseph respected God. He followed God's commands in handling the situation with Mary and going to Jerusalem to have Jesus circumcised and Mary purified after Jesus' birth. We are told that he took his family to Jerusalem every year for Passover, something that could not have been easy for a working man.

Joseph is the patron of the dying because, assuming he died before Jesus' public life, he died with Jesus and Mary close to him, the way we all would like to leave this earth.

Joseph is also patron of the universal Church, fathers, carpenters, and social justice.

We celebrate two feast days for Joseph: March 19 for Joseph the Husband of Mary and May 1 for Joseph the Worker.

The Solemnity of St. Joseph (March 19) is a special landmark this month in which we will celebrate the great honor bestowed upon the foster father of Jesus. Also the Solemnity of the Annunciation (March 25) when we ponder Our Lady's fiat. And if you are Irish (who isn't), St. Patrick's feast is another cause for a joyful celebration.

Let's us pray this month through the intercession of Saint Joseph, model of man and father to intercede for all the families in the world.

"Oh, St. Joseph, whose protection is so great, so strong, so prompt before the throne of God. I place in you all my interests and desires. Oh, St. Joseph, do assist me by your powerful intercession, and obtain for me from your divine Son all spiritual blessings, through Jesus Christ, our Lord. So that, having engaged here below your heavenly power, I may offer my thanksgiving and homage to the most loving of Fathers."


