### Grand Knights Letter

#### Brothers,

We had a lot of activities over the past couple months. We had a Superbowl Party and three of our Knights participated in the Polar Plunge. Our Valentine's Party was attended by over 40 participants who wined, dined, and danced the evening away.

We also supported the March for Life and many Parish activities.

Virginia is leading the KofC effort to purchase Ultra-Sound machines. Already this year, the Knights purchased six machines in Virginia and will likely purchase three more this year. Some sites report that 90 percent of women who view their child with the Ultra-Sound machine do not get an abortion. I argue that saving a single life is worth more than the cost of the machine — but each machine will end up saving hundreds if not thousands of lives. It's a great program.

I attended the Annual KOVAR Meeting in Richmond. KOVAR helps those with disabilities. One Hundred Percent (100%) of KOVAR donations are given out in grants. KOVAR has investments which pays their administrative costs. KOVAR is best known for the tootsie roll collections at churches and stores. Unfortunately, those donations are down about \$70K from previous years.

To make up for the shortfall, KOVAR is encouraging people to sign up for the "Amazon Smile" program where a percentage of your Amazon purchases are given to KOVAR. It doesn't cost those who sign up a thing. I went to Amazon.com and searched for "Amazon Smile" which took me to the sign up page. It was easy to sign up. Now all I need to do is log into smile.amazon.com and make my normal purchases. If I log into Amazon.com, the site asks if I want to log into smile.amazon.com. Even when you purchase something Amazon continually reminds you that you are participating in Smile. It's great. I encourage everyone to sign up, and encourage your friends.
