


Knight of the Month for March ~ Merritt Stevenson

Merritt is a 75 year old Chicago Boy! He started his activities very early in life as a teen, with jobs that included a cargo ship while it crisscrossed the Great Lakes. At 17 years he built a small planetarium and won first prize in the Chicago Science Fair. At 30 years he received his PhD in Physical Oceanography from Oregon State University. Merritt worked many years at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography in California. At 44 he accepted an invitation to work for the Brazilian Space Research Institute. After moving to Brazil, he met Vilma in the Institute library and married her in Chicago 30 years ago. Merritt worked in Brazil for 20 years as an oceanographer, participating in 7 research expeditions in Antarctica.

In 1997 the couple moved back to the USA, first to Colorado and 10 years ago to Florida. In Boynton Beach while a member at St. Thomas Moore Parish, Merritt obtained his degrees as a Knight of Columbus. Besides being the Advocate at Trinity Council #4839, he was also the Faithful Comptroller in the Loyola Assembly #2003. He was the editor of the Council, Assembly and Columbiettes' Newsletters there and began printing them in color. After moving to Port St. Lucie, he chose St. Bernadette Church for his activities as a Knight. Merritt is a very focused person and again accepted the task of being the editor of the St. Bernadette Council #13042 Newsletter. 



**Our Knights of Columbus License Plates - Do you have yours yet?**



In a Council meeting several months ago, the idea was raised about having Knights of Columbus vanity license plates produced and made available to members of our Council and Assembly. The plates are made of aluminum and overprinted as shown above. The plates have 2 mounting holes near the top for easy mounting. There are also 2 mounting holes at the bottom of the plate. If it is desired to also use the lower holes on the plate, there is a simple pop-out to make these holes apparent. Some modern vehicles may not appear to have mounting holes on the front bumpers but since most cars are sold in all states and many states require front license plates, there are almost always 2 lightly marked spots on the front bumper that are also pop-outs. The plates are available for \$12 and can still be obtained from Brother Knight Nic DiGiacomo, who is in charge of this project. Don't delay since a modest number of plates were produced.
