The month of March is a big recruitment month for the Knights with several incentives:

The Supreme council is offering the Missouri Jurisdiction \$10,000 donated to the charity of choice of the State Deputy, which will be the Special Olympics Training for Life Center IF the jurisdiction make the "Circle of Honor." We are at 51% of the goal at this time.
