What Do We Really Value?

I live a busy life. If asked, I would tell you I'm busy because I'm doing things I value. I am busy going to kid's activities because I want them to remember that I cared about them. I am busy at work because I value my job and want to make a significant contribution. I do lots of stuff with the Knights because the Order is working hard to support our Catholic Church.

And thus I feel "busy" all the time as I try to fill my whole day with stuff. Stuff that I value – mostly – but still stuff.

It is said you can really tell what a person values by looking at how they spend their time. We only have 24 hours in each day and a person tends to allocate that time based on what they truly value. Note that I said "truly" – not what we **say** we value, but what we actually do value.

Since I feel so busy – and I'd like to reduce the hecticness of my life – let's look at how I spent my time on a typical day. Let's look at Leap Day – February 29, 2012.

I got up at 5:00 A.M., read the paper for 30 minutes and got ready for work. I had to drive my 17 year old to school because the truck is broke down (again), then drove my 8^{th} grader to school and then to work.

I worked until 11 AM and went to our gym here at work (a real treat) and spent an hour working out. I then came back to work and worked until 5:30 P.M.

I then drove to Denton for the Knights of Columbus Chapter Meeting. I sat through this

meeting (1 hour of dinner and 2.5 hours of meeting) to help coordinate the Fort Worth Diocesan Knights activities. We prayed briefly and the beginning and end of the meeting (2 minutes max). I then drove home (about and hour). I went to bed at around 10:30 P.M.

So, my day broke down accordingly:

Sleep – 6.5 hours Morning Prep – 0.5 hours Work – 9 hours Driving – 3 hours Working out – 1 hour KC Meeting – 2.5 hours Eating – 1 hour Reading paper – 0.5 hours Praying – 2 minutes

So, I spent (2 minutes/24 hours) 0.14% of my day praying – and I wouldn't have done that much if I hadn't been forced to. I also spent 0.00% of my day with my family.

If you were to ask me what the two most important things in my life are, I'd first say my relationship with God and family. But the evidence from Leap Day suggests my actions say otherwise. I got work to do in this area.

How are you spending your time? Does it align with what you say you value? Perhaps this Lent would be a good time for all of us to reassess what we show we value by how we spend our time.
