Grand Knight's Letter

Dear Brothers:

"Christ IS Risen" ... "Indeed He IS Risen". This proclamation and reply echoed loudly in Monsignor Hannan Hall on Tuesday, April 16th as Deacon Sabatino Carnazzo, Executive Director of the Institute of Catholic Culture, spoke to a crowd of over 50 Knights, parishioners and guests. In his lecture, Deacon Sabatino presented "Breathing with Both Lungs: Understanding the Eastern Catholic Churches." It was a very interesting evening learning about the Eastern Catholic Church and how they are both similar and different from the Roman Catholic Church. As Deacon Sabitino pointed out -- "unity does not mean uniformity" and "diversity does not mean division". Meaning that the two churches are united to the teachings of the Holy Catholic Church but they do not do it in a uniform manner; and the diversity of having different vestments, icons vs statues, communion under different species does not make one any more or less Catholic than the other rite. It was a wonderful evening of learning about the beautiful traditions and practices of our Eastern Rite Catholics. My thanks to Deacon Sabatino Carnazzo, Father Joseph and Father Charles (who accompanied Deacon Sabatino) for an enlightening and inspiring evening. Special thanks goes to Henry Dubois for arranging this wonderful presentation. This was the third in a series of Spiritual Outreach seminars we have done this year in support of the Holy Father's Year of Evangelization. As we plan for next year, we would like to be able to have 4 to 5 seminars to provide a deeper and more meaningful understanding and appreciation for our faith.

This past month we also conducted Casino Knight. Although the turnout was light, everyone who attended had a wonderful time. A special thanks goes to Brother Matt D'Ercole, President of "Always Fun Casinos" for providing the Las Vegas style tables, environment and dealers. Through Matt's generosity and the labor of so
