

This year, we will be joined by our patriotic brothers from Father John P Washington Assembly of Yorktown in commemorating "The Four Chaplains", sometimes referred to as the "Immortal Chaplains" or the "Dorchester Chaplains". These were four United States Army chaplains who gave their lives to save other civilian and military personnel as the troop ship SS Dorchester sank on February 3, 1943, during World War II. They helped other soldiers board lifeboats and gave up their own lives when supplies ran out. The chaplains joined arms, said prayers, and sang hymns as they went down with the ship. There will be free tours of the War Museum in addition to food and beverages provided by Assembly Sir Knights. We invite each of you and family members to join us in commemoration of this event starting at 2:30 p.m. on Sunday, May 29.


