

God Bless you and your families!



It was suggested that we buy carnations for the mothers of our parish for Mother's Day. Dave Yaniko pointed out that we have done this in the past. It had been discussed at our March planning meeting and Matt Casey took an action item to check around with potential suppliers for prices. It was suggested that we would need 1500 carnations at an estimated price of about \$800. Matt checked with Greene's Florist (\$1.49 per/stem), Walmart (\$1.39 per/stem), Dallas Wholesale florist as suggested by Dave Yaniko (\$0.49 per/stem), and GlobalRose.com (\$0.42 per/stem). GlobalRose.com was able to offer a \$0.42 per/stem, or \$630 total, which was \$105 less than the other best estimate. Can only approve \$500 at "Emergency Business Meeting". Dave Yaniko made motion we approve \$500 to go towards Mother's Day flowers, Ray 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion approved. Robert Pica suggest having the mothers stand up at Mass and ushers distribute the flowers.
