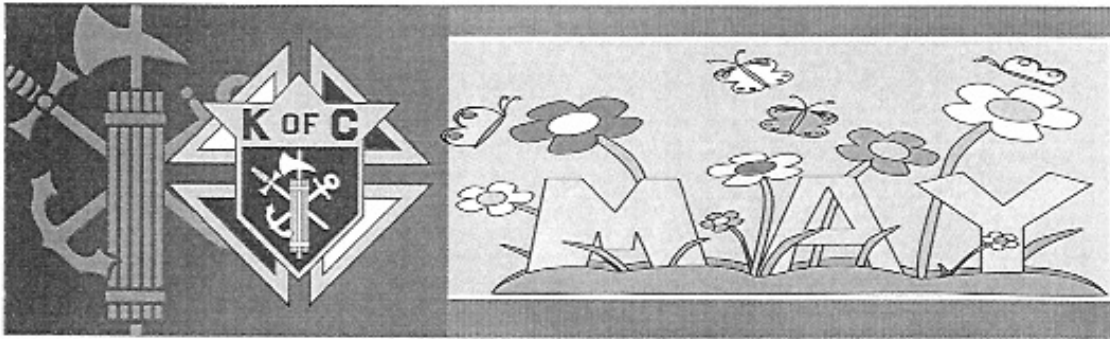
## BABY SHOWER
