Scripture gives us very little insight into the day to day life of Jesus. Sure we get a few insights into some of the major highlights, but no real indication of his daily activities between his birth and his introduction in the synagogue in Jerusalem. I sometimes think about what it must have been like to watch the child of the Almighty grow up. For those of you with children, you will recall the formative years of rearing your own children. This is the time when relationships are built, lessons are taught, and closeness is developed especially between a mother and a son.

I bet if I interviewed 100 of you, to a man, each of you would have the utmost adoration and respect for your Mom. If your mother asked you any of you to complete a task, no matter how important or trivial, you would do it out of the love that was built for her when you were small. The devotion to Mary goes back to the apostles and is especially reflected in Jesus' command to us and his mother at the foot of the cross. However, the devotion in May doesn't go back as far as you may think. It might come as a surprise that it wasn't until the late 18th century that this devotion arose among

Jesuits in Rome. In the early years of the 19th century, it quickly spread throughout the Western Church, and, by the time of Pope Pius IX's declaration of the dogma of the Immaculate Conception in 1854, it had become universal. May

crownings and other special events in May in honor of Mary, such as public recitation of the rosary, stem from this time. Sadly, such events are rarer today, but we can take the month of May as an opportunity to renew our own devotion to the Mother of God by dusting off our rosaries and adding a few more Marian prayers to our daily routine.

This month, our council will be paying close attention to the Queen of Heaven. Not only will our first degree and major degree ceremonies held at our Parrish be dedicated to Our Lady, but as Knights, we give special devotion on Mother's Day by placing roses near the statue of Mary in our church.

Take some time this month, not only to thank your mother, but to give thanks to Our Mother for her devotion to our Lord and to us.


Mother's Day Breakfast
