Hall Rentals

Anyone interested in renting the hall needs to be a Knight in good standing. Membership in our council is not required...members from any K.C. council can rent the hall.



No outside beverages are permitted. A bartender is included with hall rental and drinks must be purchased through the bar.

Lower Hall Rentals

The lower level is named in honor of our newsletter's former editor and is called the Bill Wolf Memorial Club Room. Rental of this room is \$250 with a \$200 deposit. Room seats up to 110 people. There is a kitchen and refrigerator available and included with lower hall rental.

Upper Hall Rentals

Without a Caterer

Rental of the upper hall is \$550 with a \$200 deposit. The upper hall can seat 240 people. You cannot use the kitchen but you can bring in crockpots and roasters.

Need a Caterer?



If using an approved caterer, the cost is \$12 per person with a \$200 deposit to the Home Association. An additional \$14 per person is the cost for food from an approved caterer. This price applies to both the upper and lower halls.

Bar Details When Renting Upper and Lower Hall

Included in the rental of either hall is a bartender for 4 hours with or without a caterer. After 4 hours, there is an additional \$25 an hour charge.



Beer Cost ¹/₂ Barrel Beer is \$175

Open Bar

The renter pays per unit and gets 10% off the final bar tab at the end when hosting an open bar. This includes cocktails, beer, and soda.

Cash Bar

Each person pays per unit.

Draft beer is \$2 a glass or \$8 a pitcher. Miller Light, Blue Moon, or Bud Light are on-tap upstairs. Bud Light only downstairs.

Bud, Bud Light, Busch, Natural Light, Bud Select, Miller Light, and Stag will be available for \$2.50 a bottle. Blue Moon and Michelob Ultra will be available for \$3 a bottle.

Soft drinks and water will be \$1 each. Flavors include: Coke, Diet Coke, Dr. Depper, Diet Dr. Pepper, Orange, Diet Orange, Diet Rootbeer, and Sprite. Peach and tonic water will also be available.
