GRAND KNIGHT'S CORNER

Following is an update on the process of canonization of our founder, Fr. Michael J. McGivney:

Dominican Father Gabriel B. O'Donnell, who is responsible for presenting documentation to the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, in Rome, recently provided additional information to this group. The current investigation centers around a reported miracle attributed to the intercession of Fr. McGivney. The documents will become part of the Holy See's consideration of the authenticity of this miracle. Medical experts and theologians will study the material and consider the matter. The judgment of these two groups will form an important element in the final decision.

Also, Fr McGivney's life, work, and holiness is under investigation by historians and theologians. If their judgment is positive, then the matter will move forward to the Holy Father who could then issue a Decree of Praise. Fr McGivney would then be called "Venerable". If a miracle is authenticated by the Congregation for the Causes of Saints the Pope could then beatify our founder. Let us pray that additional elevation of our founder occurs in the near future. 
The need for blood in Southern Arizona remains critical. If you cannot donate on
