The Baptism of Jesus:

The feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the end of the Christmas season, and the beginning of Ordinary Time.

In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus presents himself to John the Baptist for baptism.

Because baptism implies that a person has repented, John hesitates at baptizing Jesus. However, Jesus must be baptized to reveal that he is the Christ (the Anointed One). His Baptism marks the start of a new world, a new creation.

John baptized Jesus by immersing him in the water. His rising up from the water provided a picture of his death, burial, and resurrection.

Sunday's Gospel represents the first in the long line of readings telling us about Jesus' teachings, healings and miracles.
